Settle into your room and enjoy lunch before embarking on your first afternoon game drive.</p> <p>Umlani is a rustic bush camp that is run on solar power and is totally “off the grid”. It’s exactly how the African wilderness should be experienced!</p>	<p>DAY 1 JOHANNESBURG - TIMBAVATI GAME RESERVE</p> <p>From Johannesburg International Airport (O R Tambo), check-in to your flight to Hoedspruit town – the gateway to the Kruger National Park! Your safari guide will meet you on arrival in Hoedspruit and take you on a scenic 2-hour drive to the luxury Ngala Tented Camp, in the heart of the Timbavati Private Game Reserve.</p> <p>Settle into your stunning tented room and enjoy lunch and an afternoon nap before embarking on your first afternoon game drive.</p>
<p>DAY 2 & 3 TIMBAVATI GAME RESERVE</p> <p>You’ll be woken up early by nature’s dawn chorus and embark on your morning game drive! Enjoy lunch and high tea before embarking on your afternoon game drive.</p>
